

APPENDIX 1: Christ Church Brampton Attendance

- Our fiscal year is July 1 – June 30. Hence the 2024 attendance recorded below is from July 1 2023 to June 20 2024.
- Prior to COVID
 - The average Sunday attendance was staying between 200 and 250 people
 - We held 3 services on a Sunday and some people were double counted if they attended more than one service.
- During COVID
 - Attendance records were not reported as per Dioceses guidelines
- After COVID
 - Attendance is split between online and in-person.
 - There is one in-person service on Sunday and attendance has been steadily growing.
 - Online services became an important way Parishioners worship during the Pandemic, and continue to be important for the Parish especially for:
 - Parishioners that are shut-ins
 - Parishioners that are uncomfortable with crowds
 - Parishioners that are travelling but still want to worship with Christ Church Brampton
 - Total attendance is back to pre-pandemic levels
- Online attendance: services are on You Tube and the numbers below are “Views” as reported by YouTube. Please note:
 - You Tube counts a view if the recording is watched for at least 30 seconds, hence in some ways online attendance might be over-counted
 - If more than one person is watching the service in front of one computer, You Tube counts this as only one view, hence in some way online attendance might be under-counted.
 - During COVID diocese suggested multiplying views by 1.7 to get online attendance, but this does not match our expectations. Instead, we used the raw “view” counts
