Recruiting - Part Time Associate Priest

As announced on Sunday, June 19th we are currently recruiting for a Part-Time Associate Priest. With Michelle Jones' appointment to St. James Caledon Eastlast November and an unsuccessful attempt to secure a Curate, we had to revisit our pastoral staffing plan. It will come of no surprise to many of you that Christ Church is of a size that it requires an additional priest but also that it is always a financial challenge for Christ Church ~ this is not new news. There is lots of written correspondence in our archives for at least a generation, if not two, supporting that. At this point, the Corporation felt that the most prudent course of action would be to recruit for a part-time positon on a one-year contract. We remain hopeful that we could extend it.

The posting, released on June 20, closes July 18. Ideally it would be good to have someone in place for September. While ultimately the hiring decision is with Corporation and the Area Bishop, over the next couple of weeks we will be forming an interview panel as a broader perspective is welcome and a good practice. As always, regular updates will be provided.

The ask:

- The job posting is available on the website. Please consider sharing it with your networks.
- For users of Facebook and Instagram: We will be using both these platforms to advertise so please look for the posts, like them and share them. A positive comment gives the post more traction on these platforms.
- Commit to praying about who God might be calling to Christ Church.

Change to Online Worship

Since the March 2020 our online worship has been pre-recorded with the volunteer team Stephen Nilam, Andrea and Jeff White doing a spectacular job for which we are most grateful. That said, with pandemic restrictions being progressively lifted over the last several months and people returning to in-person worship, there has come a need to revisit this model. We have learned during the pandemic that having an online presence is important ~ indeed there are many in our parish family (and beyond) that worship with us in this manner.

We will be moving to a model of "live-streaming". This means that we will be filming the service on Sunday morning and broadcasting live simultaneously over YouTube **<u>BUT</u>** there are a few technical kinks to work-out so we are taking a phased approach.


- Phase 1 (completed): Testing on Sunday morning ~ some of you may have noticed the camera in church on the last several Sunday mornings
- Phase 2 (*started June 26*): Filming on Sunday morning and releasing that taped service on Sunday afternoon at 4:00 pm in place of the 10:00 am online service. We refer to this as "tape-delayed".
- 3. Phase 3 (to be determined): Live-streaming the 10:00 am inperson service.

Phase 2 - A little more on "tape-delayed"

- Commenced <u>Sunday</u>, June 26th for an interim period while we work through some of the technical needs to broadcast simultaneously.
- Access to Online Worship will be the same as always ~ simply go to our website at: <u>www.christchurchbrampton.ca</u> and click the YouTube icon.
- <u>The service will be available at 4:00 pm</u>. A survey was conducted of identifiable online viewers and this was the preferable time. Thank you to our online friends who adapted to this change. It gladdens our hearts.



Guidelines for In-Person Worship

We are delighted that you have joined us this morning for in-person worship. We are currently following the guidelines of the 2022 Green Phase of the Diocese of Toronto's pandemic response. These protocols keep our In-Person Worship safe.

- Greeters will assist with arrival, seating and exiting. We ask that people enter through the glass doors and exit through the tower doors. There will be access to the ramp.
- The offering plate will not be passed. Offerings for blessing may be placed on the offertory plate as you enter the church.
- Our service is entirely projected on the screen and congregational responses are in black.
- Masks are optional, however many will still be wearing them.
- With capacity limits lifted, you are welcome to sit where you would like. <u>However, we kindly consider sitting from the front of</u> <u>the church to the back and do be mindful of other people's</u> <u>need for personal space.</u>
- Accommodation has been made for those who are more comfortable with a bit more space. Pews have been designated for this.
- Communion will be distributed at the bottom of the steps.

Anglican Diocese of Toronto Mandatory Vaccine Policy On September 17, 2021 the Diocese of Toronto's Covid-19 Mandatory Vaccination Policy was released requiring clergy, employees and volunteers to be fully vaccinated and provide evidence as such. We are in the fortunate position that our Clergy, Staff, Wardens and Production Team have been fully vaccinated for some time now, however we will need to further expand our scope to any participants in worship including readers, intercessors, Altar Guild, etc. Essentially anyone who carries in-person activities on behalf of the parish either inside or outside falls under this policy. As important, please know that proof of vaccination is not required to attend worship.
