I'm so looking forward to our Holy Week services. We have worked very hard to prepare for you, your family and friends a great celebration of all that Jesus has done for each and every one of us. Our worship will be available in-person (NO pre-registration required) and virtually (via YouTube - easily accessible through our web site).

Here are four specific things that you can do to celebrate Holy Week:

1. Invite your friends and bring your family!

We all know friends that are LOOKING for a church to attend on Easter, even though we may feel nervous about inviting them. But, when one invites a friend or family member to join them for church, they often do come, and even if they can't, they appreciate being asked. An easy invitation could be to the Good Friday Family Prayer Walk ~ after all we are all part of God's beloved family.

2. Attend as many Holy Week services as you can.

Please come, not only for (Palm) Sunday of the Passion and Easter Sunday, but also on Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and to The Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. By this you will get a full picture of the Way of the Cross and the amazing story of our redemption.

3. Help out in any way that you can.

If you see ANYTHING that needs to be done - a piece of paper that needs to be picked up, a person who needs a question answered, a pew that needs to be left for visitors, or a parking spot close to the church that needs to be left free for someone else - I encourage you to "just do it." One of the great things about Christ Church is the way we all pull together to do whatever is needed to welcome our Lord's guests.

4. Personally celebrate the Good News of Easter, starting today!

Just think of it: because of Easter our past is forgiven, our life is worth living and we have the gift of eternal life! Romans 3:22 says, "We are made right in God's sight when we trust in Jesus Christ to take away our sins. And we all can be saved in this same way, no matter who we are or what we have done." (NLT).

Holy Week 2022

During Holy Week, we journey from the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday through the drama of Holy Week to the glory of Easter. Whether you are joining us in-person or online, we hope that you will journey with us. With two notable exceptions all our services are available both in-person and online:

New Good Friday Family Prayer Walk at 11:30 am is in-person only. We start and finish at Christ Church to walk 4km of easy paved pathways in downtown Brampton and along the Etobicoke Creek. Lasting approximately 1 hour, we will stop at various points along the way for prayer and reflection. Please note that there is a stairway to gain access to the Etobicoke Creek Trail.



Also New Good Friday Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm is on Zoom. While this service is not new to us, this year it will be available on Zoom. Much like Evening Prayer, the Zoom link will be readily accessible on our website and you will be placed in the "waiting room" until we begin.


Sunday School Returns to In-Person on Sunday, May 29

How to Give

As we look to the future and imagine our possibilities, we offer a reminder on ways to give:

- 1. You may make an e-Transfers via the Interac system.
 - a. Simply set-up Christ Church Brampton as a payee on your internet banking account.
 - b. Email address required: christchurchbrampton@bellnet.ca
 - c. No password is required
 - d. Upon making an offering you will receive an email notification as will Christ Church.
 - e. Your offering will be included in your annual tax receipt.
 - f. If you believe that we do not have a correct/current mailing address, please include your address in the notes so that we can provide a tax receipt.
- 2. You can donate electronically via <u>CanadaHelps</u> using your credit card through the Christ Church Brampton website. At the top of the homepage click "Online Giving via Canada Helps". It takes you to the following link. In this case, CanadaHelps provides you with a tax receipt.

Moving to Green Stage

On March 23, 2022, the Diocese of Toronto released an announcement about churches within the Diocese removing Covid-19 restrictions. It read in part:

"With faith and trust, and in deep thanksgiving, we announce today that the Diocese of Toronto will move to Green Stage - the removal of all COVID-19 restrictions, except the vaccine policy for staff and volunteers - as of April 27. On that date, across the Diocese, the wearing of masks becomes optional, all parishes may resume the informal sharing of food and drinks (e.g., coffee hours) and may once again offer the Common Cup in the Eucharist. Those parishes that are not ready to move to Green Stage by May 1 should speak to their bishop."
