Please join us we journey through Holy Week ~ from the triumphant entry into Jerusalem through despair and death to joyful resurrection.

Palm Sunday – March 29

10:00 am In-Person | 4:00 pm Online

Holy Week begins with the Sunday of the Passion (Palm Sunday) as we make the journey from Jesus's triumphant entry into Jerusalem to his utter rejection and crucifixion. Incense may be used at this service.

Maundy Thursday – April 2

7:00 pm In-Person

At this celebration of Holy Communion, we remember Jesus's Last Supper and his charge to love one another through the washing of feet. We end the service by stripping the altar. Incense may be used at this service.

Solemn Liturgy of Good Friday – April 3

Join us we remember Christ's suffering, crucifixion, and death on Good Friday with a service of Scripture, music and ancient prayers.

Good Friday Prayer Walk – April 3
