



ICV is currently in the midst of sponsoring Gul Sher and his family. Gul Sher is a Pakistani Christian and was with Shahbaz Bhatti on the day he was assassinated by Taliban militants. Gul Sher is currently separated from his family and living as an unwelcome refugee in Thailand with his family still in Pakistan. ICV is looking to raise the balance of \$50,000 needed to bring Gul Sher and his family to Canada. This annual fundraiser is part of that effort.

International Christian Voice (ICV) is a registered Canadian Charitable organization and Sponsorship Agreement Holder (SAH). ICV serves to sponsor asylum seekers, who are victims of religious persecution and supports their resettlement in Canada. Since 2017, they have settled 135 refugees consisting of 46 families. In 2021-2022 alone, they welcomed 101 people. Our parishioner, Javaid (Jim) Bakhsh is very involved in this ministry.

Christ Church is humbled to support the work of ICV and welcome the opportunity to attend this Fundraiser Gala. Consider joining us for the evening. Tickets are \$120 for 3-Course sit-down meal. Tax receipts will be issued through Christ Church, Brampton.
