We launched the Parish Survey on Sunday, May 5th, and our goal is to have the input complete by Sunday, May 19th. The survey should take approximately 15 minutes to complete.



He also taught at several seminaries. A priest in the Anglican Church of Canada, he is a Benedictine oblate. In the last thirty years, he authored or edited a dozen books addressing the intersection of faithfulness and daily life. His award-winning books include *The Way is Made by Walking: A Pilgrimage Along the Camino de Santiago, Never Call Them Jerks: Healthy Responses to Difficult Behavior,* and *Living into Focus: Choosing What Matters in an Age of Distractions.* His most recent book is <u>Shattered: A Son Picks Up the Pieces of his Father's Rage</u>, a sensitive and penetrating reflection on coming of age in a Dutch immigrant family scarred by violence.


